2 If the election for Congress were held today, would you vote for Republican Jaime Herrera Beutler or Democrat Carolyn Long?*

44% Republican Jaime Herrera Beutler
40% Democrat Carolyn Long
16% Not Sure

4 Do you favor or oppose term limits for members of Congress?*

54% Strongly Favor
25% Somewhat Favor

Methodology

The survey of 500 Registered Voters in Washington-3 was conducted online by RMG Research, Inc. from July 29-August 4, 2020. Respondents were selected at random from voter lists and through a Random Digital Engagement process. Certain quotas were applied, and the overall sample was lightly weighted by gender, age, race, education, and political party to reasonably reflect the district's population of Registered Voters. Other variables were reviewed to ensure that the final sample is representative of that population.
